

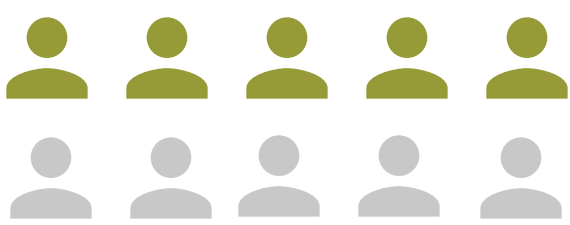
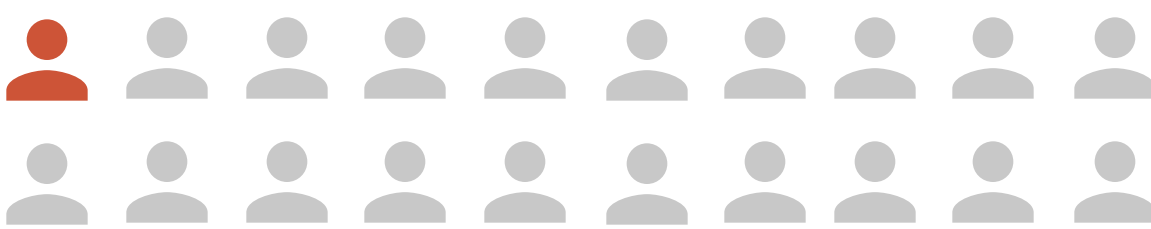

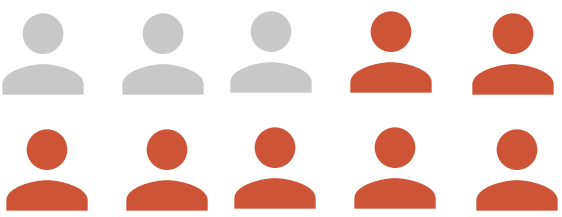

**Indigenous peoples make up just 3-5% of the total population of Canada...**



**but 26.4% of the total federal inmate population is Indigenous**



**and 36.7% of the total federal women inmate population is Indigenous.**

**Indigenous peoples are...**



**more likely to be classified as high security risks, be segregated, return to prison**



**less likely to get parole, access corrections or culturally appropriate programming, be released on time**

**2007 - 2016**



**39%** increase in the # of Indigenous inmates

**5%** increase in the federal prison population

*Over the same period, Caucasian offenders incarceration dropped 14.7%*



**Every year between 1985 -2016, the federal incarceration rate of Indigenous people rose.**

**Every single year.**
