

Indigenous peoples make up just 3-5% of the total population of Canada...



but 26.4% of the total federal inmate population is Indigenous

and 36.7% of the total federal women inmate population is Indigenous.

Indigenous peoples are...



more likely to be classified as high security risks, be segregated, return to prison



less likely to get parole, access corrections or culturally appropriate programming, be released on time

2007 - 2016



39% increase in the # of Indigenous inmates

5% increase in the federal prison population

Over the same period, Caucasian offenders incarceration dropped 14.7%



Every year between 1985 -2016, the federal incarceration rate of Indigenous people rose.

Every single year.
