## **ABOUT THE POSITION**

The Research Assistant will assist Dr. Damien Lee in the delivery of a Ryerson Faculty of Arts-funded project entitled *Indigenous Self-Government in Canada and Russia: A Comparative Approach*. The purpose of the project is to establish principles for international political research collaboration between Indigenous scholars in Canada and Russia.

Duties include collaborating on the following:\*

- Prepare background materials for a project meeting taking place in Iowa, USA in mid-February, 2019. Note: The research assistant is not expected to join this meeting, and there are no project funds to support travel.
- Provide support to meeting participants on an as-needed basis.
- Assist Dr. Lee in preparing minutes and other materials produced or called for during the meeting noted above.

## **QUALIFICATIONS**

- Must be enrolled as a graduate student at Ryerson or another Canadian university (preference given to PhD students but masters students are strongly encouraged to apply);
- Preference will be given to those whose work experience or education focus deal with Indigenous governance and international issues in a critical way;
- Excellent written communication skills and attention to detail;
- Demonstrated understanding of settler colonialism;
- Have access to computer equipment and internet;
- Must be Indigenous.
